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Frequency of Reporting

Veterinarians will submit dispensation data to Clearinghouse, at a minimum of every 7 days. Veterinarian data uploads are due weekly, on Mondays, with a 6-day grace period

Additional Requirements

All practitioners who prescribe controlled substances in the State of Connecticut must hold an active

- Connecticut Controlled Substance Practitioner (CSP) Registration with the State of Connecticut and an active CT DEA # registration.
- Gabapentin and naloxone are reportable.
- Section 2.1 of the Dispensing Guide: “Dispensing veterinarians are the one exception to the 24-hour reporting requirement. When dispensing more than a 48-hour supply of controlled substances or gabapentin, veterinarian data uploads are due weekly, on Mondays, with a 6-day grace period.”

Reportable Qty

Greater than a 72-hour supply
